## I. Old Business

A. Review and Approval of Minutes of June 9, 2011 Meeting- Minutes were approved as written with compliments to the author for their unbiased nature.

B. Treasurer's Report- Linda reported transactions for the prior month ending with a balance of \$19,241.50. It was noted that Meg Dyer has returned her coaching stipend- thank you, Meg.

C. Outcome & Announcements-

Programs end August 4th but there will be a triathlon on August 5th at 9 AM at the Narrows Beach.
5. Lovell Old Home Days- Girls softball team will have a float, Dunking booth at the fields. There will be a bike displayed that will be raffled at the Tour de Lovell. Pick-up softball game in the afternoon.

## II. New Business

A. Vote on Nominations for Lovell Committee Seats- Members present could not recall if we had voted to change by-laws to increase membership. Mike will amend the by-laws to read "up to 20 members" and make it possible that another town could have a second member on the board, but that it would be a nonvoting seat. No vote was taken for the current vacancy.

B. Play set Research- Mike has submitted to [Mulford](#) Fund for \$1000 toward the play set. With the current Maine guidelines, the set may cost up to \$4000. Research continues.

C. Tour de Lovell changes- Finish line has been changed to be at Wicked Good Store. However, Walter Grzyb has recommended that it start and finish at the same location, so maybe the start should be at the Wicked Good Store as well. John [Weston](#) will man the timing. The race is starting at 8 rather than 9. Help will be needed early on and afterwards for cleanup. There will be a cookout after for the volunteers.
