

SELECTMENS MINUTES

Present: Bob Drew, Rick Eastman, Larry Fox (road comm.) Gene Spender (G.L.L.T. rep)

1. David Morine came in to discuss his property tax situation in regards to the division of his four lots last year at his North Lower Bay Road property. We told him that we would have Parker Appraisal review it the next time he came to Lovell.

2. Cheryl & Bruce Trimpop came in to strongly suggest the need for speed limit signs on Slab City Road. Cheryl told of many situations to bolster her case. We told her that the D.O.T. was reviewing this. We suggested the Slab City Road Committee make a list of the hazzard signs they wanted, and the locations of them. We would then meet with them on sight and review them. Cheryl left a letter voicing her views on the matter. She also left a disk from the D.O.T. explaining how speed limit signs are delt with. A copy of both are in the minutes book.

3. Ben Eastman cut the ballfield for Larry as the Town crew was in the middle of the Pleasant Point Road project and did not have the time.

4. We discussed hiring out the cutting of the ballfield and cemeteries.

5. Pike Industries paved Pleasant Point Road on 10/05/07. The town crew will shape and seed the ditches this week. Larry told us he was unhappy with the way Pike removed a lot of the grindings from the top of the road and pushed them into the ditches while grading the road. He also told us that he did not like the way they used the paver on the hill. He felt there were areas where the pavement was about one half the thickness it should be. Larry will contact Pike and set up a meeting with their representative to discuss these matters. He will also tell them that he expects them to stand behind their work should any problems arise because of them.

6. Gary Crowell came in to discuss moving a power pole located on the Towns' property in Lovell Village. This pole will interfere with the Libraries new addition. He also gave us a copy of an agreement that the Selectmen signed years ago stating that if the pole ever had to be moved the town would pay the bill. We told him we would meet with him at the location and view this. This will also affect the pole which supplies the tennis court lights.
