

SELECTMENS MINUTES

1. Kathy Stone came in to talk about applying for a grant from the Maine Historical Society.
2. D.E.P. along with Clean Harbor has addressed the issue of the oil spill from the outside oil tank at the town office. They will continue to monitor the situation.
3. We reviewed liquor licenses for Severance Lodge and the V.F.W.
4. Bob Drew, Larry Fox and Mark Moulton met in Lewiston with Steve Greeley from the Bureau of Labor Standards Work Place Safety and Health Division. The deficiencies at the Transfer Station, Town Garage, and the Town Office was corrected to their satisfaction along with the air lines and electrical issues at the three Fire Houses. There was some additional paperwork that was asked for regarding the Fire Dept. training, procedures, ect. Lovell's Fire Chief Mark Moulton will supply the additional information.
5. Larry Fox said the man selling the John Deere grader at the Turner Airport would accept the \$16,000.00 offer we proposed.
