Selectmen's meeting minutes April 8, 2008

Attendance- Rick Eastman and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, Mark Moulton and Gene Spender were also there.

1. We approved last weeks minutes.
2. Al St Germain came in to tell us that Stephen Bennett was awarded Groomer of the year. There will be a presentation Saturday in Bangor.
3. We received some info from the Maine Community Heritage project. This will be a joint project with both libraries in Town and the Molly Ockett Middle School as well as the Academy.
4. We signed the warrant.
5. Rick will contact Al Frick regarding our dump permits.
6. Lynda Rasco and Bill Rudd came in to discuss a letter that they had brought in the day before. This letter was about the fuel spill at the Town Office and also about some compensation they felt they were due. Steve explained that this letter was faxed to him on Monday and when he received it he called Buzz to find out how to handle this so that he would have some answers for the meeting on Tuesday. According to our attorney's advice he suggested that we fax him a copy and he would handle acknowledging the receipt of the letter. He told Steve to have all communications go through him. We had a discussion about what had happened and how Lynda Rasco and Bill Rudd felt about this and what their opinions were on this. We ended the discussion and told them that we have turned this over to our attorney.
