Selectmen's meeting minutes July 29th, 2008

Attendance- Bob Drew, Rick Eastman and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox and Gene Spender also came in.

1. We approved last weeks minutes.
2. Mike Mendonca came in to discuss the summer recreation program. He told us that tennis and swimming were up in participants this year. It appears that there is a great deal of programs and everyone is doing a fine job and enjoying all the activities.
3. We signed the warrant.
4. Kevin Rooney the President of Severance lodge came in. He came to thanks us, as the leadership for the town, for all that we have done; they really appreciate it.
5. The Cushman Pond project is moving forward,
6. We did not receive any bids for the North Lovell Fire Station. We will put it out to bid again.
7. We received a letter from the American Red Cross, this was an agreement with which allowed the Recreation program to conduct Red Cross Swimming classes.
8. We received a letter from Paul and Carol Brown regarding their tax bill. Apparently they have a small camp/cabin and we have not sent them a tax bill on it. They would like to pay their fair share.
9. Larry filled us in with the progress that has been made on Slab City road. Pine Tree paving has been working on the road. We will be paving 1 mile from Heald Pond road north.
10. Charlie Fowlie came in and he wanted to discuss two items. First, he had a concern that our Town auditor was just now asking for the Fire Department books when he had previously sent these in. he felt that this was not good business and he expressed his concerns over what poor service we were getting. We told Charlie that we were aware of some difficulties and that we were going to have conversation with the auditor.  
Charlie next told us that several people on the budget committee including himself had expressed concerns that they were not receiving enough budgetary information from us that allowed them to make better informed decisions. He

requested that we prepare a budget for each department and present it to all members at the annual budget meeting.

We told him that we would have something for them.

11. Bob spoke to the dock people. The docks will be pulled for the remainder of this year. The need to be replaced. We will be getting a quote from them on the price of new docks.
12. We have had some complaints about the mess at the transfer station. Steve and Bob will go down on Thursday and talk with Scott.
