Selectmen's meeting minutes August 19th, 2008

Attendance- Rick Eastman and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox and Gene Spender also came in.

1. We received information about a mid week ski pass at Shawnee Peak. A copy is in the minutes.
2. Heather from the Oxford County Soil and water conservation came in. She is an Americacore volunteer and she is working with the conservation committee in mapping out 20,000 acres of land in the Saco River Corridor. She did a power point presentation for us and identified the 10 species of plants she is mapping. These are: purple loose-leaf; multiflora rose; Japanese barberry; garlic mustard; Japanese knotweed; Autumn/Russian olive; oriental bittersweet; common buckthorn; glossy buckthorn and black locust.
3. We signed an agreement with Harris software (TRIO) for training on the new budgetary software.
4. The Cushman Pond project is moving forward,
5. We received a copy of the Sheriff's log from the incident at the transfer station.
6. Dick King came in to see who is responsible for the memorial at the library. They would like to add some names and wanted to know who pays for this. We told him we could put an article in the Town report setting up a fund for this; He will get back to us.
7. We discussed the returnables. Rick and Steve will be working on this.
8. MMWAC will be disbursing their profit to all member towns shortly. Our share should be around \$10,000.00.
9. We received some information from the State about some mistakes made in the tree growth reimbursements. We should be getting around \$5,000.00 more.
10. We received some information from CMP about lighting.
11. We received information from MMA regarding the election results.
12. We received a letter from J. Mack docks. When we are ready to discuss replacements we should contact Jon Maclean at 831-2397.

13. Larry will be purchasing sand from Tibbetts this year. It will be \$8.50/yard delivered. We will order 25 yards.
14. We received a letter from Peter Rohr regarding the water skiing course on the lake. We have received letters in the past from him and we have been told by the State that we have no jurisdiction on this. Rick will call Mr. Rohr.
15. We talked about the mowing at the Cemetery again since we had some more complaints. Larry will handle this.
16. We have received quotes for steel for the roof at the North Lovell Fire station. Lovell Hardware was \$4.16/foot; Records \$3.79/foot; Paris Farmers \$3.62/foot
