Selectmen's meeting minutes August 5th, 2008

1. We approved last weeks minutes.
2. Sandy Dutton was in and she asked us if we could remove the metal signpost that had the Crime Watch sign on it. She thought that it would look much nicer if we attached that sign to the building and removed the signpost. She also asked if we could try to shape up the East side of the building and grass it in.
3. James Willey, a selectman from Sweden came in and asked if he could bring in some tires from a property that they are cleaning up in Sweden on Knights Hill Road. We told him that as a one-time deal we would accept the tires and we would charge them \$5.00 per tire.
