

## AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

Question \_\_\_ : Shall the Solid Waste Management Ordinance of the Town of Lovell be amended, to allow the Selectmen to contract with neighboring towns to allow joint use of the facility subject to town meeting approval, as set forth in a document dated 12-8-2010, a copy of which is available from the Town Clerk?

*Note: The symbol of "\*\*\*\*\*" indicates that there is missing text that will remain unchanged, which has been left out of this document for the purpose of brevity. Underlines indicate proposed language to add, and ~~strikes~~ indicate proposed removals of language.*

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1. The Board of Selectmen will set the hours that the solid waste facility will be open.
2. This solid waste facility is for the use of residents and taxpayers of the Town of Lovell only, except that the Selectmen, subject to the approval of the Town Meeting, may contract with other Towns to allow its use by non-residents or non-taxpayers, with terms that do not burden the residents and taxpayers of the Town of Lovell.
3. Persons depositing refuse at the site will deposit only where designated by the attendant on duty.
4. There will be no fires ignited at the disposal site except by persons authorized by the Town of Lovell.
5. Whoever violates these Ordinances will be subject to a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100).

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON A PART OF  
CHURCH STREET, LOVELL MAINE**

**Question \_\_\_** : Shall the Ordinance of the Town of Lovell regulating parking on a part of Church Street be amended, to change restrictions to the northeasterly side of the street, as set forth in a document dated 12-8-2010, a copy of which is available from the Town Clerk?

1. On Church Street, in Lovell Village, between its junction with Route 5 and the former Jim Plummer place, vehicles shall only be parked on the ~~southwesterly~~ northeasterly side of the street; all such parking to be parallel parking only.
  
2. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than one hundred dollars

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TOWN BEACHES,  
AND TOWN LANDINGS  
~~, TOWN PROPERTY AND RUBBISH DISPOSAL IN LOVELL MAINE~~**

Question \_\_\_ : Shall the Town Beaches and Town Landings Ordinance of the Town of Lovell be amended, to clarify permitted users and set restrictions on dogs and fires, as set forth in a document dated 12-8-2010, a copy of which is available from the Town Clerk?

*Note: Underlines indicate proposed language to add, and strikeouts indicate proposed removals of language.*

1. This Ordinance shall supercede and replace all previous Town Ordinances regulating the use of Town beaches and/or landings in Lovell, Maine.
2. No bottles, cans, or other trash shall be left on any Town beach or Town landing, except in containers provided by the Town for same.
3. No fires shall be permitted on any Town beach or Town landing except provided as follows:
  - A. WEST LOVELL: Wood fires allowed, but only in fireplaces provided by the Town, and on the lake side of the road; charcoal fires allowed, but only in metal charcoal braziers; also self-contained camp stoves, utilizing a connected fuel supply, such as gas or white gasoline, may be used if approved by Underwriters Laboratory.
  - B. HORSESHOE POND, BRADLEY POND LANDING, CUSHMAN POND LANDING, FARRINGTON POND LANDING AND HEALD POND LANDING: No wood fires allowed; charcoal fires allowed, but only in metal charcoal braziers; also self-contained camp stoves, utilizing a connected fuel supply, such as gas or white gasoline, may be used if approved by Underwriters Laboratory.
  - C. FARRINGTON'S PLEASANT POINT BEACH LANDING, MILL POND LANDING, NORTH LOVELL LANDING AND SEVERANCE LODGE LANDING: No fires of any kind permitted.
  - ~~D. SEVERANCE LODGE LANDING: No fires of any kind permitted.~~
  - ~~E. NORTH LOVELL BEACH AND LANDING: No fires of any kind permitted.~~
  - ~~F. MILL POND LANDING: No fires of any kind permitted.~~
  - ~~G. BRADLEY POND LANDING: Same limitations as Horseshoe Pond.~~
  - ~~H. HEALD POND LANDING: Same limitations as Horseshoe Pond and Bradley Pond.~~
  - ~~I. CUSHMAN POND LANDING: Same limitations as Horseshoe Pond, Bradley Pond and Heald Pond.~~
4. No watercraft shall be left moored or beached, even temporarily, at any Town Beach or Town Landing, except at the North Lovell Landing, where the same may be moored and/or beached for an aggregate not to exceed no more than twenty-four (24) hours in any forty-eight (48) hour period calendar week; ~~it being intended that, with the exception noted, no watercraft shall be at any Town Beach or Landing except while actually being launched into or retrieved from the water.~~
5. ~~No person except a resident or landowner in the Town of Lovell, his immediate family, and accompanied guests, will be allowed to use any of the picnicking, beach, or bathing~~

facilities at the West Lovell Town Beach. Use of Town Beaches and Picnic Areas is limited to the following:

- a. Residents and landowners in the Town of Lovell, members of their households, and their accompanied guests;
  - b. Occupants of temporary lodgings in the town; and
  - c. Participants in Town recreation programs, swimming activities, their parents or guardians, and program supervisors, while such activities are taking place.
6. No water craft shall be launched into the waters of Kezar Lake, or retrieved therefrom, at the West Lovell Town Beach, except at the ramp provided for such purpose at the southerly end of said beach.
  7. No water skiing is permitted from the West Lovell within two hundred (200) feet of any Town Beach.
  8. No tents and/or overnight camping is permitted at any Town Beach or Town Landing.
  9. All Town Beaches and Town Landings on Kezar Lake, and all parking areas in connection therewith will be closed to use from ~~10:00~~ 9:00 p.m. of every evening until 6:00 a.m. of the following morning: provided that this shall not prevent watercraft from being launched and/or retrieved during the hours closed, nor the leaving of unoccupied vehicles in such areas pending return of watercraft. At the North Lovell Landing, overnights parking shall only be permitted for the owners of Birch and Sheep Islands.
  10. ~~All dogs at the town beaches and/or landings must be kept on leash, and no dogs are permitted to be in the water.~~  
No dogs are allowed on any Town Beach, except for service dogs.
  11. On all rights-of-way leading to all town beaches and town landings, the maximum speed limit shall be 15 miles per hour.
  12. No persons shall cause any tree, bush, or other vegetation, whether living or dead, to be mutilated, cut, damaged, or severed from or on any town property, but this shall not apply to persons duly authorized to manage such property by the Town of Lovell or authorized by its Selectmen.
  13. No person shall put or place or cause to be put or placed in any public disposal container (not to be construed to include town dump), any garbage, rubbish, refuse or junk from any residence, cottage or other structure which was created by or from residential, cottage, or private homes; intending to prohibit hereby the dumping into such container, household type trash originating from private dwellings.
  14. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~ten~~ fifty (50) dollars and not more than ~~one~~ five hundred (500) dollars.
  15. The Selectmen may adopt further regulations as necessary for Town Beaches and Landings.
  16. This Ordinance shall remain in effect for one year from the time of its adoption.
