SELECTMENS MINUTES

4 / 28 / 09

1. Jim Sweigart came in to get his concealed weapons permit.
2. Ed Bergeron of H.E.B. Engineering came in to discuss the sealed bid opening for the Cushman Pond Dam project. The opening was at 3:00 P M on Friday the 24th of April at his office in North Conway NH. There were several contractors present. The low bidder was Drew Corporation of Lovell, Me. at \$92,663.10. The next lowest bidder was SR General Contractors of Lewiston, Me, with a bid of \$93,569.30. Mr. Bergeron said that after reviewing all the bids and based on the completed bid and their lowest bid price, H.E. Bergeron Engineers recommends that the Town of Lovell award the contract for the Cushman Pond Dam project to Drew Corporation. Selectman Bob Drew to avoid any conflict of interest is abstaining from any further discussion or voting on this issue as the owner of Drew Corporation is his son.
3. Larry said he has some qualified people asking about the summer jobs and he feels that he will not have to advertise for help.
4. Larry has ordered the new engine for the Case bulldozer.
5. Bob is meeting with Mike Mendonca and Sports Fields of Maine on Wed April 22 at the athletic field to determine a location for the new girl's softball field.
6. Bob meet with the D.E.P. at the town office. The D.E.P. said we could remove the vertical monitoring culvert which was installed because of the oil spill of the outside tank. The D.E.P said they would contact Norris Bennett Excavation to remove the Culvert.
7. The water heater at the town office is leaking. Ron McAllister was contacted to replace it.
8. It was brought to our attention that we should get a certificate of insurance from the person who holds the oil burner license as well as Paul McLaughlin regarding the replacement of the furnace at the Town Office
9. Bob stopped at Jon Bliss's office and informed him that Larry said there was an existing chamber septic system in the ground that was installed for the Annie Heald School just before it burned. This system may be able to be used for the Library as they do not have a location on their own property to accommodate their expansion. This will have to be accomplished at a special Town meeting.
