

## Town Of Lovell

### Selectmen's meeting minutes March 17th, 2009

Attendance- Rick Eastman, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox was also present

1. We approved last weeks minutes.
2. Mark Moulton and Roger Woodward came in to discuss the Mill Pond Dam. They wanted to know if we, the Town had any plans for that dam. We do not at this time. We told them that we had a discussion about the possibility of some Hydro plans. Bob had been in contact with some agencies and we first need to get the Flow Rates. Bob had a deed of the property. The Town has a right of way over the property. The Town owns the Dam. We have been told in the past that there is no real liability downstream for the Town. The bridge has been replaced within the last 5-6 years. Roger and Mark voiced their opinion of what a valuable resource this is as a water supply. They are both very willing to work on investigating alternatives for this.
3. We discussed a school resident issue. Steve had spoken with Maddy about this and they will take it from here.
4. We help a liquor license hearing for the following establishments: Lake Kezar Country Club; Quisisana Resort; Kezar Lake Marina; Severance Lodge; Pleasant Point Inn; Center Lovell Inn; and Ebenezer's. There were no oppositions so all were approved. Rick made the motion and Bob seconded it. All voted in favor.
5. We discussed the placement of the utility pole at the Library. As soon as CMP sends us the required paperwork we will sign the forms.
6. Sandra Masse came in to discuss a complaint that she has. Apparently she and her husband have made several complaints about the Molloy dog(s). One dog in particular is out and threatens Sandra, baring its teeth. She also complained about the barking, the geese noise, the sheep/lamb noise as well as the order from the manure. Since she has not had any luck in dealing with the ACO, who is Meryl Molloy, it was decided to use Kathleen Hathaway; Fryeburg's ACO. Steve will be in contact with the Town of Fryeburg as well as Kathleen.
7. We signed the County's Assessment forms.
8. We received the Rec minutes.
9. We received a brochure on Grant Funding.

10. We received information from Time Warner.
11. We received the formal letters that are going out to the recipients of the McKeen Fund.
12. Bob spoke with Buzz Pratt regarding the legality of the Selectmen meeting with another organization and then going into executive session. We are not allowed to do that.
