1. Accepted previous minutes.
2. Bill McCormick came in to discuss moving the power pole at the Library.
3. J Mac Docks have removed the docks at Farrington's and West Lovell beaches. They also reported that the docks at the narrows are in disrepair and that they will have to be fixed before they are installed next year. He thought the damage occurred by being hit by a boat.
4. Signed two concealed weapons permits.
5. George Abott told Larry that he could haul the metal at the dump right away for \$50.00 a ton. We decided to wait for Grimmel Industries to haul it as they will pay us \$75.00 a ton.
6. We discussed the problem with the removal and maintenance of the screens at the Cushman Pond Dam We will meet with the engineer at the sight at 5:30 pm on Tuesday October 13th. The milfoil committee also was invited to attend.
7. The town will now be buying its winter salt from Eastern Salt at the Merrill Terminal in South Portland. The delivery charge and price will be the same. This is due to a merger between Morton Salt & International Salt which the Federal Government thought would create a monopoly in the region.
8. The asphalt shingle container is costing around \$1,300.00 - \$1,400.00 a trip to send. We may want to bring this up at budget time.
