Selectmen's meeting minutes November 24th, 2009

1. We reviewed the real estate transfers.
2. We accepted the minutes from last week.
3. Jason Wentworth came in for Wallace Allen to discuss their trash service and what they were doing for Sweden. They will just be picking up residential trash. They will not be using the packer truck for this. In fact they use the white van for the other towns of Stow and Chatham as well.
4. We discussed some possible solutions to our transfer station and how we could cut down on inappropriate sorting of debris. We plan on drafting a letter to explain this along with a penalty schedule if people violate these new rules.
