

## Town Of Lovell

### Selectmen's meeting minutes June 23rd, 2009

Attendance- Rick Eastman, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox was also present.

1. We received abatement for taxes, which we will pass on to Bob Gingras.
2. We received a report from Sysko regarding the possibility of a hydroelectric plant at the mill pond dam.
3. We received a bill from the Conservation Committee requesting we send money to fund the 4-H camp at the University.
4. We received a certificate of Insurance from McLaughlin, who is doing the furnace work.
5. We received a notice from Time Warner regarding the cable service.
6. We read the Lovell Rec's newsletter.
7. We received Mike's mileage report from Lovell Rec.
8. We received a letter from MMA regarding the slate of officers for the Executive committee.
9. We received a letter from Maine Resource Recovery Association regarding our dues for this year.
10. Mike Mendonca came in to present us with a letter of intent for the Eastman Hill Fund for the Fencing at the Ball field.
11. Bryan Molloy came in to discuss some issues he was having with the Town and certain community members as well as the Lovell Recreation. We discussed these issues for about an hour.
12. James Willey from Sweden came in to discuss the contract we were signing with the Town of Sweden and the Transfer Station. We signed the contract. Sweden for this year gave us \$18,750.00 at the signing and will give us the remainder of the \$8750.00 by September 1<sup>st</sup>. Going forward we will be collecting \$17,500 on a yearly basis.
13. We discussed a telephone conversation Steve had with Charlie Dattelbaum regarding appointed him as a Constable for the Town. Steve told him that on the

advise of some Police officers it would not be a good idea to appoint anyone as a Constable without that person having a 100 hour law enforcement class.

14. We discussed the Tennis Courts and the upcoming meeting with the State regarding the Grant Application.
15. We discussed putting our banking out to bid. Steve and Sherry will be working on this.
16. We decided to set this year's mil rate at \$9.15. This represents a half of 1% increase (.5%) over last years rate.
17. Someone called Larry to talk about putting the buoys on the lake. He stated they were in the wrong place. Larry will contact him and have him do the job.
18. Al St Germain called Rick to ask him for an endorsement for the GLLT in a State application for the Best Conservation Group of the Year. Rick told Al that he could not do that.
19. We received the performance Bond from Drew Corp for the work to be done at Cushman Pond.
20. Larry had the water tested at the Town Garage and the results came back and the water is fit to drink.
21. We discussed the merit raises for this year. Bob made the motion and Rick made the second to give a Larry a merit pay raise for Larry taking on more responsibilities at the Transfer Station. We will discuss the figure at next weeks meeting. Steve abstained because of a conflict.
22. Steve received an e-mail from Susan Parrish regarding the lake level and when the Town will be removing the boards in the Dam to lower the lake. The Town does not do this. Steve will e-mail her back with this information.
