Selectmen's meeting minutes July 21, 2009

Attendance- Rick Eastman, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox was also present.

1. We approved last weeks minutes.
2. Sandra Masse came in to discuss some concerns she had. She also brought with her a written complaint against the Molloy's concerning their barking dogs, as well as their animals getting into her yard. The board last week had asked her to write up a formal complaint. Sandra also had concerns about fireworks at the public beach, drinking at the beach, and campfires late at night. She also was concerned about a Town resident who drives his motorcycles up and down the road at what she says is an unsafe speed and not in a prudent manner. We told her that she should call the fire chief for the fire works, as they are illegal and Oxford County or the State Police for the other issues.
3. Meryl Molloy came in to discuss her concerns with the Masse complaint. We told her to respond to the complaint in writing. We will then turn this over to Bobby Silcox's the alternate ACO.
4. The ladder on the floating dock is broken. We will have the Town crew fix this next week.
5. Bob spoke with Buzz Pratt about the easement for the library. Buzz said that he was working with Mike Friedman and that it would be ready next week. Buzz wanted to add a few things to the easement. He wanted wording to allow the Town in the future to pave this road; he wanted to specify the width of the road; as well as the size of the leach field.
6. Steve informed the group about the tennis court grant. Part of the application asks to have a committee in place for this. The selectman appointed Mike Mendonca and Maureen Duggan.
7. We Larry informed us that he has purchased a 2001/2002 Mac Road tractor. With the trade and the swapping of the wet system it will cost \$22,000.00+-.
8. We will post one side of Christian Hill (Church Street) for no parking.
9. We took a ride down to the narrows public beach and inspected the area. Larry and Steve drove around the Molloy property. We did not hear any dogs barking or see any animals loose. Larry and Steve also drove to Ebenezer's and noticed that

people were parking on both sides of the street. Steve went in and spoke to the owner's sister about this.

10. We received a request for an abatement.
11. We received the rebar drawings back from HE Bergeron's for the Cushman Pond project.
12. We received some information from Time Warner; a copy is in the minutes.
