Selectmen's meeting minutes August 24th, 2010 EDITED

Attendance- Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, Scott and Scott Gardiner.

1. A group of people from the KLWA, the GLLT and the LIPPC came in to discuss some milfoil issues. Representing the KLWA were Charlie Dattlebaum, Tom Hughes and John Crowe. Also present were: Paula Hughes, Ann Williams, Bill McCormick (representing GLLT), Dean Stearns, Gerry Nelson, and Bob Stellar, the last three representing the LIPPC.
Charlie Dattlebaum read to us a proposal that the KLWA had written in regards to an action plan for the control of milfoil on Kezar Lake. A letter from Ed Poliquin (representing Timber Bay Shores) was also read. A discussion followed with some good exchanges of ideas. It was decided that the Selectman would have a meeting with both of these groups so that we could work out some details and wording for some Articles to be put into the 2011 Town meeting Warrant. The group would like to see an increase in the days and hours spent on Courtesy inspections. They also would like some newly designed signs, a limit to public launch sites in Town, a power wash station, and some more educational efforts. These will be discussed further in an upcoming meeting.
2. We accepted the minutes.
3. We signed a concealed weapons permit.
4. Steve signed a cemetery lot conveyance.
5. We signed the warrant.
6. The quote Larry had for us last week on the concrete work from Dunlea was \$5295.00. A quote for a floor was \$3450.00, which we decided we would not do at this time.
7. We reviewed a septic plan design for the Center Fire Station.
8. Turf has installed a "Public Service Bulletin Board" at the transfer station.
9. We reviewed a watershed report.
10. Steve discussed with the group that he had contacted MMA regarding culverts, ditches, and road maintenance. They will get back to him with some legal information.
