Selectmen's meeting minutes April 21st, 2009

Attendance- Rick Eastman, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox was also present.

1. We approved last weeks minutes.
2. We signed a liquor license for Pleasant Point Inn.
3. We signed the warrant.
4. We discussed the bulldozer again. To rent a bulldozer would cost \$1100.00 per week or \$2100.00 per month. We decided to fix the bulldozer. A new complete, motor will be \$8680.00. The labor to install this should be around \$2,000.00- \$3,000.00. Rick made the motion, Bob seconded it and we all voted in favor.
5. We received information from Maine Health and Trust regarding COBRA coverage. It does not apply to our Town.
6. We signed two (2) bills of sales for Cemetery lots.
7. Bryan Molloy came in. Paul Bois was also with him. Bryan wanted first to talk on his wife's, Mery, behalf. This was in regards to her ACO duties. He read a letter that she wrote a copy is in the minutes.
Bryan then wanted to discuss the qualifications regarding the person putting in the new furnace. We told Bryan that before any work will be done that the licenses and proof of insurance would be reviewed.
Regarding the GLLT, Bryan feels that they are harassing him. He feels that Gene Spender claims to represent the Town and is going around claiming that his property is polluting the lake.
We made it clear to Bryan that Gene Spender was the liaison between the Town and the GLLT. We told him that Gene was a board member and could vote how he felt on issues. We told Bryan that we, the Selectmen, do not always agree with Gene, but we feel that Gene is doing a great job keeping us informed.
Bryan filled us in with what he is doing and we the Selectmen felt that he was doing everything that we have asked him to do regarding his livestock.
8. We received the package from Goodwin's Insurance. The Total cost for the Town this year is \$16,634.00
9. Rick had a talk with Scott Davidson about some issues at the transfer station.
10. Steve reported that he had spoken with Jon Bliss and Buzz Pratt about some issues that have come up regarding the septic system at the library.

11. We voted to forgive the interest on a tax bill for Robert Baker. There are some health issues surrounding this.
12. We discussed the new accounting program and set a deadline of June 1,2009.
13. Rick found on his desk the license for the oil furnace installer. It is Sean Heavin and his license is good from April 2009-March 2011. Paul M had insurance through Pikes and that is until June 2010.
