Selectmen's meeting minutes March 10th, 2009

Attendance- Rick Eastman, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox and Gene Spender were also present

1. We approved last weeks minutes.
2. We raised at Town Meeting \$860,753.36. This was \$500.00 less than the limit on LD1 and an increase over last year of 2.93%.
3. We signed the warrant.
4. We discussed MMA's answer to a written ballot and we will have it on hand for next years meeting.
5. Mike Welch agreed to serve on the Economic Counsel.
6. We received our County Assessment. It will be \$367,951. This is an increase from last year of \$31,281.00 or 9.29%. Our Town is valued at \$564,150,000.00.
7. We have 1 drug test for the month of March.
8. We received the MMWAC report.
9. We gave out 14 awards for the John McKeen fund. We had 15 applicants but one was incomplete. We gave all 14 applicants \$1,200.00.
10. We voted to go into executive session at 9:20 to discuss personnel issues.
11. We came out of executive session at 10:15.
12. We had received a letter questioning why Rick had his car registered in N.H. Rick explained to us that:
 1. He had spoken with a Maine Trooper who told him that there were too many loopholes in the law and that it was not an enforceable rule. And
 2. That he had called N.H. and they told him if he had a business in N.H without a garage it was ok to bring his car home and have it registered in N.H and if he were servicing his clients by using this vehicle to go see them that was another justification for having it registered in N.H. Kate is using this vehicle for her business which is a N.H. business.
