Selectmen's meeting minutes October 12, 2010

Attendance- Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, Scott and Scott Gardiner.

1. We received some information from Southern Maine Regional Planning Commission regarding the awarding of the sign bid to Perma Liner Corp.
2. We accepted the minutes from last week.
3. We received some information from Affiliated Health.
4. We received a letter from the University of Maine about the scholarships they awarded to two of our residents this year. They are Kelly Margeson and Kathleen Powers. They each received \$1,000.00. These are given as a gesture to the Town since they acquired the Hewn Oaks property.
5. Mark Moulton and Tom McKenzie came in to update us on the new fire truck purchase. The cost for this truck is \$231,728.00 and they have all but \$50,000.00 for this. They are asking that we put an article in this years warrant to raise and or appropriate this amount of money. The Selectman supports this.
6. We reviewed the real estate transfers.
7. Steve gave an update on some legal matters that he had received from Buzz.
8. We have set a meeting for 10/26/2010 we the LIPCC, GLLT and KLWA.
9. We received some information about solid waste facilities.
10. We signed the new General Assistance Ordinance.
11. Steve signed the MMA Workers Compensation Risk Management Forms.
12. We received some information about accident insurance for firefighters.
13. We received some information from Time Warner.
14. We discussed the Tennis Courts and decided to have two additional coats of paint put down. This will put us over the total cost of the grant by about \$985.00. We all agreed to do so.
15. We reviewed the figures we have so far this year on the dumps. We have decided to take the total cost which as of now is \$207,331.00 and divide that by the tonnage figures we used last year of 973 and we get \$213.00 per ton. We will be

meeting with Stow and Chatham next week to present to them what we feel it will cost them. We are open to a five-year contract with an annual review.

16. We went into executive session at 8:50. A motion was made by Bob and seconded by Turf. All voted in favor. This was to discuss a personnel issue and Larry was also invited. We came out of executive session at 9:05. It was agreed that if any Town employee wants to donate some of their sick or vacation time to another employee that we would allow this.
