Selectman's meeting minutes, July 20, 2010

1. We accepted last weeks minutes. Turf made the motion Bob seconded it, all voted in favor.
2. Larry reported on the progress of the digging up and resetting of culverts before paving begins next month
3. We discussed the North Lovell Cemetery. We need gravel roadways to keep people from driving over the soft field. This project will require the marking of the roadways, removal of sod, and then laying a bed of gravel. Larry will look into this project for the near future.
4. Spoke with Scott G. about his job description, Scott asked that the job descriptions could be reviewed as a group with the selectman and road crew employees. A time will be set after they have all had a chance to review the job descriptions; Larry forwarded a copy to each employee.
5. Larry explained the state's merit raise system used with their road crew employee's.
6. Steve informed us the work on the tennis court would begin Aug. 9th; he will put a notice in the Bridgton News
7. Scott Gardiner found us a Quonset Hut style building; it is a 30 x 44 ft. metal storage facility at close to the cost of a 25 x 34 ft. we had been considering. Larry felt the crew would be able to assemble the building again saving us more money. We all voted in favor to order the building. Thank You to Scott for taking his time to help the town in locating and procuring a larger and safer building. We appreciate his efforts.
