Selectmen's meeting minutes September 7th, 2010

Attendance- Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, and Scott Gardiner and Scott Davidson were also there.

1. We accepted the minutes of last weeks' meeting as well as the revised minutes' from August 24<sup>th</sup>. Steve explained to the board that Ann Williams had edited the minutes of the 24<sup>th</sup> and he had told her should could not edit any minutes. He explained to the board that she wanted to add the affiliations of the people present at that meeting. The board also discussed the fact that minutes should be posted on the Lovell Page as soon as possible after they are sent. The board also discussed that if the minutes are amended or edited in the future that they would stop sending the minutes.
2. Robin Prescott came in to discuss the gifting of 1.3 acres to the Town at the Fire Station for the septic system. She wanted us to have the deed reflect that if any access is needed it should be done through the Fire Station property. 3. We signed the warrant.
4. Bob wrote a letter in support of the Red Iron Bridge.
5. Gene Spender came in to discuss some updates with the GLLT. He informed us that there were 4 four new members: Carol Gestwick, Phoebe Mointeith, Phil Mead, and Heinich Wurm. Gene also told us that he will be running a spreadsheet regarding the impact on Lovell's taxes should their been an adverse effect due to any invasive plants on the lake.
6. We signed an application for a catering event for Lakes Region Catering.
7. We will tell Ed Dunlea to stay with the plans for the foundation for the new building.
8. Dick Dunham will be taking some sick time for medical reasons.
9. Larry informed us of his progress on the roads; specifically Christian Hill, Sabattus Road and West Lovell Road.
10. The tennis court project is moving along. We voted to have them clean and color the basketball surface (one coat), stripe it, and re-stripe the net line on the

bangboard for \$400.00 as well as to Loaming and seeding (including mulch) around perimeter of tennis court for \$750.00.

11. We discussed an e-mail that we received from Stow and Chatham regarding the transfer station and we will be working on a new contract with them.
12. We discussed the signage at Ebenezer's.
13. Janice has informed us that \$3,160,650.00 has already come in for taxes out of the \$3,919,682.00 we are to be getting. (This is over 80%)
14. We will have a Public Meeting on Wednesday September 28<sup>th</sup> at the Town Hall to discuss Lovell's beaches.
15. We received a letter from Howard Corwin regarding his ideas about methods to prevent invasive plants.
