

Town Of Lovell  
Selectmen's meeting minutes March 15, 2011

Attendance- Bob Drew, Turf Ramsden, and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox and Scott Gardiner, were also present.

1. We accepted last week's minutes.
2. Michele Windsor from Oxford County Soil and Conservation came in to discuss what her group does for the Towns in Oxford County. A copy of information is in the minutes.
3. We agreed to have the Selectmen's photos on the web page.
4. Scott Davidson came in to talk about the Town buying boots for the transfer station employees. He felt that since they do not take the uniforms and because they do not spend all the money that it would cost for uniforms that he could spend the remainder to purchase boots. We all voted to table this at the present time.
5. We discussed how to better word the Town Ordinances that did not pass at Town meeting. We also discussed adding a Tow Away ordinance for cars that block the roadways.
6. We have received the septic application. We have sent out the necessary notifications for this. Apparently we need to do this every 5 years.
7. We received the MMWAC minutes.
8. We read a letter from Adam Armington expressing his willingness to be a continue being a courtesy Boat inspector this summer.
9. We received some information form Oxford County regarding this year's budget. There will be an increase of around \$25,819.00 this year. Our share will be \$388,293.00.
10. We received a request for money from the Progress Center.
11. We received a copy of a consent order from the State of Maine Department of Health and Human Services regarding some issues at the Center Lovell Market.
12. The money in the John McKeen Fund that we can distribute this year is \$22,689.47.
13. The LIPPC committee has hired Marty Prox.

14. We reviewed all the Bank information and we decided that because of the low interest rate environment we would not move our accounts at this time. In order to protect the Town's account we will have to make sure that we keep just \$250,000.00 at each bank which is the FDIC limit. Bob made the motion, Turf seconded it. Bob and Turf voted to stay where we are and Steve abstained.
15. We discussed the Town Hall.
16. We discussed driveway permits and 911 numbers.
17. We discussed the Family Medical Leave laws and how to make a policy for the Town.
18. Larry told us about the quotes for the new truck. Whited Ford was \$35,600.00; Ripley's was \$52,245.00 and McDonald Motors was \$38,000.00. We decided to go with Whited Ford.
19. Larry will get some prices for 7 signs that we need at the Transfer station.
20. Larry told us that Bonnie Fox had reviewed all notes regarding roads in the Town from 1938 to 1945. Her information is being put in the Road Book for future reference.
