

Town Of Lovell
Selectmen's meeting minutes April 17, 2012

Attendance- Turf Ramsden, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith, Tommie McKenzie, and Larry Fox were also present.

1. We accepted last week's minutes.
2. Glen Holmes from the Western Maine Economic Development came in to discuss with us his organization and what they do and how it might help Lovell. He also discussed with us the states new plan "Open for Business" which seeks to identify and recognize communities that show a true commitment to business development. A copy is in the minutes.
3. Ron and Sandra Masse came in to voice several concerns regarding the beaches. They are upset with the drinking at the Narrows, the dogs at the Narrows the open fires that are left and the after hours parties. They were looking for some support from the Selectmen if they go over to confront people who are violating these rules. We told them that we would support their efforts but they should be mindful about their safety and call 911 for most issues. They also were concerned about the leaving of trailers at the landings. We suggested that the planning board, which Ron is a member of, clean up the wording in the ordinance books to address this.
Lastly they wanted the Town to put some more gravel down where the electrical cable was buried for the wash station.
4. Bill Dale called and suggested that we send the person involved a bill for the vet charge and if after 30 days we have not received money to go to small claims court.
5. We announced those who were awarded the work for phase II of the Lovell Town Hall. They are:
 1. Foster Maxwell for the carpentry work
 2. Addison Mason Builders for the roofing
 3. Harville Painting for the painting.
6. We signed the warrant.
7. We discussed the parking lot at the library as well as the swings. We will meet next week at 7:00 to view this. We will also be viewing the trees at the number 4 cemetery.

8. We received some information from Baker Commodities; a copy is in the minutes.
9. We signed 3 concealed weapons permits.
10. We discussed the water level at Cushman Pond Dam. We will check the files for the pre determined water level and in the interim we will add one plank.
11. We will be going with option 1 a three year plan for financing the new truck.
12. Larry reported to us about a workshop he had recently attended about Trees, Weeds and right of ways. We will look into documenting all of our town roads and identifying the road names in the "Old Town Road Book"
