Selectmen's meeting minutes May 31, 2011

Attendance- Turf Ramsden, and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, Scott Gardiner, and Tom McKenzie were also present.

1. We accepted last week's minutes. Turf made the motion Steve seconded it, all voted in favor.
2. We opened the bids for the septic system at the fire station. We received eight (8) bids. E&R Excavation \$27,100.00; LBI Construction \$22,975.00; Morgan Construction \$20,975.00; Glenn Builders \$18,900.00; Norris Bennett \$8,475.00; Searles Excavation \$21,310.00; Robert Hanson \$17,494.00; and LA Drew \$19,975.00. Steve made the motion to go with Norris Bennett, Turf seconded it and we voted in favor. We will need to see proof of insurance.
3. Phoebe Monteith and Bob Winship came in. Bob wanted to introduce himself as the new prospective President of the GLLT. Both Bob and Phoebe wanted to discuss the possibility of putting in a parking lot for the hiking trail to Amos Mountain at the North Lovell Cemetery. We did not see a problem with this and we will be meeting there next week at 6:15 to look at the project. We have not budgeted for a parking lot at the end of the area but we will get some idea of prices so that we can budget for it next year.
We also gave permission for access across the Town's property and to install a sign depicting the trail. A map is in the minutes.
4. We signed the warrant with a few corrections.
5. We received some information from the US census and Bob will fill this out.
6. We discussed the KLWA boat patrol position and the job qualifications. Bob will contact the warden service for advice.
7. We discussed the Boat Patrol and are waiting for a reply from the Department of Wildlife and Inland Fisheries.
8. The LIPPC received a grant for \$5,000.00 to be used for the Courtesy Boat inspection Program.
9. Larry met with Mike Clark from the DEP regarding the septic site. Bob and Al Frick will be sending in the new application.
10. Larry has been working on the Sabattus Mountain road by Fred Sater's.

11. Larry has hired Harry Nyberg to take down a pine on Slab City Rd.
