Selectmen's meeting minutes June 7, 2011

Attendance- Turf Ramsden, Bob Drew and Stephen Goldsmith. Larry Fox, Scott Gardiner, and Scott Davidson were also present.

1. We accepted last week's minutes. Turf made the motion Bob seconded it, all voted in favor.
2. We met at 6:15 at the North Lovell Cemetery to view the proposed parking area for Amos Mountain. We flagged out an area for this.
We then went to Cushman Pond Dam to view the screens.
Bob Winship was called and told to look at the proposed site to make sure we were all on the same page.
3. Ann and Bob Williams came in to discuss a concern they had with the rate of speed some drivers are going in Center Lovell. He would like us to put some blaze orange pennants on the 35 MPH signs. Bob will contact the state to see if we can do this. A copy of their letter is in the minutes.
4. We noticed that the minute books were all put back but when we reviewed them we noticed that they were not in the same places as they were. We also noticed that several pages were ripped by the 3 hole punch and that many pages were out of chronological order. We also noticed that several documents were not filed as they came in and were also out of date. We notified our attorney who is handling an ongoing litigation case about this and our frustration that this was the result of allowing the plaintiff's to view our records. We also found several planning board files that had not been properly put back.
5. We discussed the bid for the septic at the fire station and agreed to stay with awarding it to Norris Bennett. Turf made the motion and Bob seconded it. We all voted in favor. We also agreed to stay with the bid to Manzer for the paving. Going forward we will have to look at all new bids and specify that everyone show us both proof of insurance and proof of workers compensation. There was a new Maine Law that outlines these guidelines.
6. We signed 2 concealed weapons permits as well as approved a third, however the paperwork had not yet been completed for this.
7. We discussed the KLWA boat patrol position and the job qualifications. Steve will contact Sheriff Gallant.

8. We reviewed the application from Al Frick to the DEP regarding the septic site. We were all in favor of this. A copy is in the minutes.
9. We signed an agreement to have Trio come in to help us with the change over in the computer programming.
10. Steve retyped the warrant article 6 to show the changes. The wording did not change; they were just highlighted with bold italics.
11. We received some information from Time Warner.
12. We received some information from the State Planning Office regarding our annual Solid Waste Report. Turf will do this.
13. Larry received a bid from radio north.
14. We discussed the uniform/clothing proposed policy.
