1. Approved November 17, 2015 minutes.
2. Reviewed and signed The Warrant.
3. Discussed moving of fuel tanks at Public Works to meet with state requirements.
4. Discussed the mold situation at the Town Office, we will contact Phil Allen at Chalmers Insurance to submit the estimate for required cleaning.
5. Discussed uncompleted furnace installation at the Center Fire Station.
6. Received a Thank-You note from Paul Kurnick for our contribution towards The University Of Maine scholarship.
7. Planet Aid will no longer be doing business in our area and will remove the clothing boxes.
8. Reviewed Maine Municipal Employees Health Trust rate adjustments.
9. Reviewed the Monthly Activity Report from MMWAC.
10. Tommie reported on LVFD, laundry system is being installed, 3 sets of turn-out gear and 5 air-pacs were received from grants.
11. Larry reported on Public Works, he contacted Collette Monuments Inc. to look at options for the veteran's memorial, they suggested granite benches to balance the memorial and allow additional space for name placement. Cost estimate was \$5,000- \$6,000.
12. Discussed Safety Flood Lighting at the town garage, we will get a price on recommended replacement lights doubling the wattage for safety concerns due to increased traffic with the sand/salt shed and transfer station traffic after dark, estimate \$1,000 present lighting is out of service.
13. Voted (2-0-0) to start procedure to have Serv-Pro start cleaning the mold situation, (Steve absent).
14. Discussed cemetery plot lay out Larry will arrange a time with Sherry to match deeds with sold plots for a better view of our sold and available lots.
15. Discussed purchase of a new transfer station trailer, larry will make contact for a price in preparation of the 2016 budget. Also we requested price on replacement of the one ton truck due for replacement.
