The meeting was held at the Lovell Library and was called to order by Chairman Ryan at 7:00pm.

Chairman Ryan introduces Mr Mike Morse from Maine D.E.P. Who is here to field questions and provide information concerning shore line zoning. Chairman Ryan passes out page 22 of the ordinance book and gives a brief history as to how the ordinance was adopted in 2015, with no amendments since. Questions ensue for the Planning Board and Mr Morse. The majority of the questions center on the ordinance itself and not on how we move forward. There is frustration among many in attendance. Mr Morse answer all questions and provides insight as to what is happening on the State level. China Lake is an example of Planning Board failure. A petition with 81 signatures is presented to the Board asking to revert to the State standard and demanding action within 35 days. The frustration becomes more apparent and the beating of a dead horse continues.
