Plants

48 plants were found by inspectors. 39 were found at the Narrows, 11 in and 28 out. 9 plants were found at the North Ramp, 4 in and 5 out. 7 concerned citizens turned in plants to inspectors. All plants observed were non-invasive.

Volunteers

There were 14 different volunteers that provided 75 inspection hours. The KLWA and GLLT each adopted the Narrows ramp for a day of inspections. There were also 76 volunteer administrative hours for paperwork, training, DEP reporting, grant writing, etc. performed by the CBI Coordinator.

Boat Wash

26 Boaters washed before entering the lake. 47 boaters washed after leaving the lake.

Kiosks

50 boaters used the self-inspection kiosks: Narrows – 18, North Ramp – 14, Farrington P. – 1, Heald P. – 4, Horseshoe P. – 13.

CBI expenses for 2018

\$33,847 for payroll.

Total expenses \$34,335. \$4,200 was covered by a Maine DEP Grant.

For tax and grant purposes a volunteer hour is worth \$21.61. At this rate our 75 volunteer inspection hours are worth 1620.75. The 76 volunteer admin hours are worth 1642.11. These amounts bring the actual value of the program \$37,598.11.
